If we have enough shooters and guns to go around, we can handle 12 shooters on a relay, and that's true whether we shoot center-fire outside, or rim-fire indoors. You really have to come out and give this shoot a try. It's a blast! Thanks also to all who helped set up the range, clean up afterward, and loaned out their guns. We couldn't do this without you. Still two more Cowboy Shoots left to go for this year:

October 7 - Rim-Fire

Both shoots are on Sundays, will start at 09:30 and will be outdoors. Bring your own Rim-fire, single action six-gun and lever or pump action rifle, or your own Center-fire six-gun and Lever-action rifle (remember, your center-fire rifle must be chambered for a pistol cartridge), and we can get you on an earlier relay. If you don't have the guns for these shoots, we'll still do our best to loan you what you'll need, but you need to bring your own ammo to shoot. 60 rounds of .22 cal LR, or 60 rounds of either .38 Special or .45 Colt (Cowboy or Target Loads, Please), will do the trick.

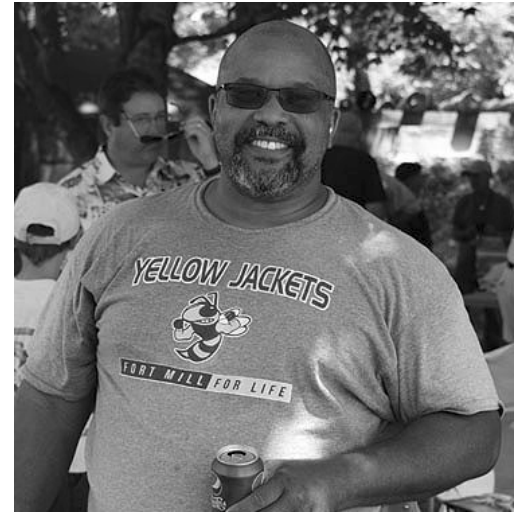
