To all black powder shooters, on the far side of the range on the left of the bulletin board I installed a piece of angle iron with two slots in it on back of one of the poles. This is to be used in the event that you load and forget to put your powder in, or for some other reason that you may have to pull the ball. I know some of our shooters are pros at loading without powder and pulling the ball. And for those of you that have never loaded without powder, believe me you will. If you do, before you pull the ball make sure you pour a little liquid down the barrel and make sure that your ball puller is screwed in to the round ball or maxi ball or whatever you may be using. And when pulling the ball make sure you pull at a steady motion and not jerking it so that you don't pull the ball puller out of the projectile.
